Writing Activities

Aim - please complete main activities and x2 additional writing activities

Main activities:

Activity 1

Watch the video story of [Superworm](#)

Talk to your child about the story

-Who are the characters in the story?

-What were the settings in the story?

-What was their favourite part?

Your child's task this week is to draw their favourite part of the story. Can you illustrate your favourite part and then write a sentence about why it is your favourite part. Please see attached links/school website for a Superworm writing sheet.

Activity 2

Can your child make a mini beast fact file? Draw pictures of the minibeasts you can find in your garden. Use the internet to search for facts about them and add the facts to your fact file. You can add to your fact file throughout the week.

Additional activities

- On Purple mash. Pick a mini beast from the selection available and write a short caption about it. Can you find this minibeast in the story? **This will be set as a 2Do task.**



- Practise writing the alphabet letters in order. Can you say the letter sound and the letter name? See Website/attached links for a tracing sheet.
- Spelling Shed games - See word lists set online.
- Water painting – Get outside and write on the paths, walls or floor with a paint brush and water. Can you write your name? or your tricky words I, to, no, go, the, he, she, we, me, be?

Subtraction

Activity 1

Practically using play dough worms (or cut up strawberry laces.) Solve Superworm's number problems. See website/attached number problems sheet. If using edible props eating the sweets is a great way to solve subtraction problems.


Activity 2

Complete the minibeast subtraction sheet, counting back to find the answer

where ever possible. Have a go at writing the full number sentence

underneath. E.g. $4 - 1 = 3$

Use a number line to support counting back if needed. A range variety of sheets are attached/on the website, please choose the most appropriate for your child.

Learning projects throughout the week

Understanding the world

- Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden. Use the checklist on the website/attached and tick what you find? Think about where a minibeast would like to live. If you are not sure – use fact books or the internet to find out.
- Digging for worms. With a grown up, see if you can find a worm by carefully digging in your garden. Be very gentle. If you find one look at it's body. How does it move? What colour is it? Does it have a face?

Creative




Make a worm picture using cooked spaghetti. Place the spaghetti in the paint and then swirl it around the paper. What patterns can you make? What happens if you drop it onto the paper?

Pasta Worms



Thread dry pasta onto string or a pipe cleaner to make your own worm. Carefully use a felt tip pen to decorate your worm. Can you make a pattern?

Purple Mash activity



Design your own butterfly, can you make it symmetrical? **This wil be set as a 2do task on Purple Mash.**
