Read to the hour and half past the hour. - Practice writing the numbers 0 -20 as words. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read the story from the Elves and the Shoemaker booklet and talk about it at the end - Answer comprehension questions on p8 - Read the riddle on page 17 - Design some clothes for the elves to wear, thinking carefully about what the elves may need <p>- Read a variety of books at home. Your child should read every day if possible. You could read your own books or read a book from the Oxford Owl library.
