Why?▪ Tell your grown-up what you liked about the story.▪ Did anything surprise you about the story? <p>Re-tell the story to an adult, these words may help you; First, Next, After that, Finally.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Use Spelling Shed to practise your common exception words and other lists set for you.- SPELLING SHED ACTIVITIES ARE ON FOR THIS WEEK – PLEASE LOG IN- Practise recalling your sounds and blending words using:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Phonics play- Phonics Bloom- Practice cursive letter formation- Complete Phonics Buster book- Daily phonics lessons <p>Phonics Lessons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Keep practice reading and writing words from the common exception word list. Practise writing each word correctly in a sentence using a full stop at the end and a capital letter at the beginning. <p>Phonics lessons will be done everyday in school.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Make a list of the rhyming words in the story.- The tiny hermit crab loves his new shell and doesn't want to share it at first in the story. Have you got a favourite toy that you find it really hard to share? Can you draw a picture of it and write about what makes it special to you?- See if you can design an even bigger shell for the hermit crab and his friends to share. Label it and write about your new design.- In the story the hermit crab shares his home with his friends. Who do you share your home with? Draw a picture of your home and write about it.- The bristle worm is really good at looking after the shell and keeping it clean to make it feel like home for his friends. How do you help take care of your home?- Challenge – The rockpool is where the creatures like to spend their time. Find out and make a list of other creatures or plants who live in rockpools.

Learning projects to be done throughout the week

1. Tissue Paper Bristle Worms

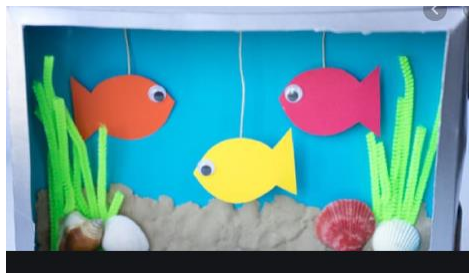
Wrap tissue paper around a straw and push it down. Drop water on it and watch it move!

4. Make an information book about Sea Creatures. Fold some sheets of paper in half to make an A5 book. On each page choose a sea creature. Draw a picture of it and write a fact about it. Make sure you do your title and author on your front cover and illustrate it. This will take you a few days to do!
