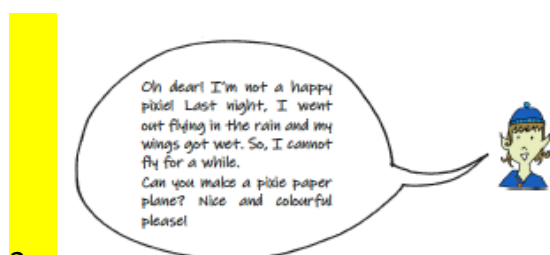
- Share the story Pippety Skycap – A Tale of Mischief. You can also listen to the story here [Pippety Skycap](#)
