


Learning Projects – WEEK 2

What colour hair and eyes do they have? What type of characters are they? Here are some words which you might like to use -Kind, brave, angry, sad, enormous - Create a comic strip or story map of Jack and the beanstalk story.

(This can be done over 2 days)

- Re-write the story but changing some things;
- 1. Instead of Jack taking the cow to market which other animal could he take? e.g. a dog, cat, horse etc.
- 2. Instead meeting an old man who gave him magic beans who else could he meet? A witch, a magician, a football player etc.
- 3. Instead of Jack taking gold coins, a golden goose and magic harp from the Giant which other objects might he take?

Learning projects to be done throughout the week

1. Can you fill in the words on the sheet on how to plant a seed?



2. Can you plant your own seed at home? Cress/beans or sunflowers are good to grow.
3. Can you draw a picture or take of photo of your seed as it starts to grow?
4. Purple Mash – Can you draw the favourite part of the story?
5. Purple Mash – Can you draw the giant’s castle?
6. Can you go on a plant hunt when you go for a walk with your family, or what you have in the garden? How many plants can you name?
