Learning projects to be done throughout the week

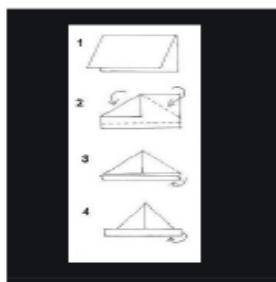
1. Make a Pirate hat and telescope! Use a cardboard tube (ie toilet roll or kitchen roll) and decorate it

What you need:

One sheet of newspaper

What you do:

1. Fold the paper in half.
2. Fold over the top corners so they meet in the middle.
3. Lift up the flap facing you and fold in.
4. Turn the hat around.
5. Now lift up the other flap and fold in.
6. Decorate my hat.



2. Make pirate treasure chest.



3. Make jewellery to put in your treasure box by threading beads or painted pasta onto string or wool.



4. Treasure hunt find treasure to put in box. Have a look around the garden and see if you can find some precious stones or bits of gold. What other treasures can you find to put in your treasure box?
5. Treasure map. Make a map of treasure island. Think of interesting places to label on your map, smugglers cove, dead mans forest etc don't forget that X marks the spot where the treasure is buried!
6. Be a pirate for the day dress up as a pirate and make a big pirate ship with old towels and sheets. Learn this Pirate songs! Can you remember the actions?
